



INTRO TO FLYBALL!

Looking for a great way to deepen your bond with your dog? Flyball is a fast, fun, team sport for dogs and their human companions. During flyball competitions, two teams of four dogs race over a course consisting of four jumps and a spring-loaded box containing a tennis ball. Each dog must run the course, spring the box, grab the ball and return with it across the finish line before the next dog can go. The first team whose four dogs complete the course without errors wins.

Dogs of all breeds (including mixed breeds), ages and sizes participate in flyball. Small dogs are especially valuable, since the height of the smallest dog on the team determines the jump height for the entire team. Some interest in balls helps accelerate the learning process. But with time, training and positive reinforcement almost any dog can become a reliable competitor.

The two-hour workshop offered at the Seattle Humane Society will introduce you and your dog to flyball jumps, the box turn and passes. After a demo by champion dogs, you'll learn techniques to build a foundation for future training. Dogs must be at least 10 months old when class begins, and their humans should pack a favorite toy or treats and wear comfortable shoes. Both you and your dog will get lots of exercise!
