

CANINE MUSICAL FREESTYLE

Saturday, February 25th, 10am – 12pm

Canine Musical Freestyle is an interactive canine sport in which dog moves are combined with dance, then choreographed into a musical performance by a dog and human team. The bond between the two are as close as any you might see in pairs figure skating, or ballroom dancing, or any team sport. In the Introduction to Canine Musical Freestyle you and your dog will learn some basic dance moves, and you'll be dancing as a team before the workshop is over!

Prerequisites/requirements:

- Your dog should have completed some basic training.
- Dogs should be at least six months old.
- Your dog should wear a regular flat collar, martingale, or harness. Choke chains/pinch collars are not allowed.
- A four-foot leash.
- Bring two cups of soft dog treats, cut up into pea sized pieces (variety is good!)
- A crate or x-pen where your dog can settle during the humans-only portion of the workshop

Instructor: Lori McKenna, CPDT-KA. Lori is the owner of Custom Pets dog training, she competes in Canine Musical Freestyle with her dogs.
