The Seattle Humane Society is celebrating [Adopt-a-Cat Month](#) throughout June! All month long, adoption fees are waived on cats one year and older.

Summer marks the beginning of kitten season and that means we are filled to the brim with nearly 400 cats and kittens who need homes of their own. Sadly, our adult cats are often overlooked during kitten season and they have to wait weeks or months for the home they deserve.

Cats of any age are playful and curious. With adult pets, you don't have to spend time teaching them all the basics – they already know them! Adopters report that they adapt to new homes very quickly and seem like they have always been there.

Top 5 Reasons to Adopt a Cat:

- ◆ **COMPANIONSHIP and GOOD FOR YOU**
