The Seattle Humane Society is offering free emergency boarding for pets of families who must evacuate their homes due to flooding in King and Snohomish counties. We can shelter, feed and care for your pets until it's safe for you to return home.

Please call our boarding department at (425) 643-5960 or email us at boarding@seattlehumane.org to make an appointment. Animals may be brought to our shelter at 13212 SE Eastgate Way, between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. seven days a week. We're located near the I-405 and I-90 interchange.

The National Weather Service issued flood phase 3 warnings Sunday for residents living in the vicinity of numerous rivers throughout King and Snohomish County.
