# Tellington TTouch® Training

Seattle Humane Society is offering a three-hour workshop on Tellington TTouch (TTouch), a gentle, positive method of bodywork and movement based on more than three decades of results with over 1000 practitioners worldwide. TTouch provides a powerful set of tools and techniques that improve an animal's performance, health, and that deepen bonds between pets and their human companions.

In this workshop, you will be introduced to tools and techniques to reduce stress in your pet. We will be focusing on TTouches and body wraps. We will also provide a brief overview of TTouch leading techniques. Using these techniques, TTouch addresses common problems such as:

- Excessive barking and chewing
- Nervousness in coping with new situations
- Leash pulling and jumping up
- Reactive behaviors
- Resistance to grooming and veterinary exams
- Car sickness
- Reducing stress for performance work, e.g. agility

You may attend with or without your dog. Please bring an x-pen or crate and a blanket or mat for your dog, and dogs must be able to stay quietly for the majority of the seminar.
