The Seattle Humane Society's Pet Food Bank provides dry and canned food every month to more than 1,200 pets belonging to low-income seniors and people disabled by AIDS, combined. Thanks to the Pet Food Bank, more than 750 pet owners each month are able to feed their animal companions.

With the downturn in the economy, the need for Pet Food Bank services has become greater than ever. At this time, we are calling on compassionate individuals, community groups, grocery stores, and pet food companies to help with cat food donations. Canned cat food is our greatest need.
