About Us

Founded in 1897, Seattle Humane is creating a kinder world for pets and their people through impactful programs and support services. We are more than a shelter—Seattle Humane is a pet resource center for the region, providing adoption services, a pet food bank and support for pet owners, low-cost spay/neuter surgeries and wellness exams, dog training, youth programs and more. Together with the support of our generous community, we save lives, complete families and keep pets with the people who love them.

Fast Facts

- 60K sq ft state-of-the-art facility in Bellevue, opened in 2017
- In our fiscal year 2025, Seattle Humane served nearly 82,000 people and pets through our many programs, and saved the lives of more than 5,200 shelter pets
- Approx. 2,000 active volunteers, equivalent to 56 full-time employees—including 300 active foster parents
- The Schuler Family Medical Center is home to our veterinary care team, and serves as a teaching hospital for more than 80 WSU students each year as part of their veterinary training
- The veterinary team provides 10,000 spay/neuter surgeries and more than 10,000 exams each year for pets in need of medical care

Community Resources

Meeting the needs of the community, we have a variety of special programs to support people and their pets

- **Pet Owner Assistance Fund:** covering short term expenses and medical care
- **Pets For Life:** expanding pet resources in underserved communities
- **Oogie's Ohana Pet Food Bank:** providing nearly a million meals each year to families and food banks throughout the region
- **SPOT (Supporting Pet Owners in Transition):** temporary foster care for pet owners in transition
- **Spay/Neuter & Community Clinic:** low cost spay/neuter, wellness care, microchips and vaccinations
