



The Who, What, When, Where and How of Puppy Socialization

Set your puppy up for a lifetime of confidence!

Why Socialization Matters

When people bring home a new puppy, they often focus on obedience—but early **socialization** is even more important. It's the process of gently and safely exposing your puppy to people, animals, places and experiences they'll encounter in life. **Puppies who aren't socialized early will likely have behavioral challenges.** Well-socialized puppies grow into dogs that are confident, resilient, adaptable and less fearful in new situations.

When to Start: Now!

The critical window for puppy socialization is **3–16 weeks old**. Puppies can safely attend well-run puppy classes one week after their first round of vaccines, if proper health protocols are followed.*

What to Socialize Your Puppy To

- **Experiences:** car rides, alone time, vacuums, vet clinics.
- **Sounds:** vacuums, hairdryers, doorbells, phone alerts and more.
- **Smells:** dogs experience the world through their noses and exposing your puppy to a variety of safe, new scents helps them build confidence and feel more at ease in unfamiliar environments.
- **People:** a variety of ages, sizes, skin tones, voices, clothing styles, ways of moving and personal expressions.
- **Animals:** other dogs and species (safely).
- **Surfaces:** grass, stairs, sand, concrete, etc.
- **Handling:** ears, paws, mouth, tail (great prep for vet visits and grooming).

Tips for Safe Socialization

- Avoid dog parks—they pose health and behavioral risks.
- Use strollers, carriers or the car to safely observe without being on the ground until vaccinated enough to do so.
- Keep exposure short and positive or neutral.
- Let your puppy set the pace—don't force it, retreat if necessary.
- Watch for stress (barking, freezing, avoiding).
- Use treats and play to build positive associations.
